














































































































Small differences in fees and charges can have a big impact on your investment over the long term.

At the end of the year, Chris received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$1,646 (that is 16.46% of his initial \$10,000). Chris does not pay any other charges. This gives Chris a total return after tax of \$1,550 for the year.
